1. a) That the subject (interviewee) is an ordinary South African who is not an ANC Member.
b) That he left the country (SA) in 1984 and stayed in Botswana ever since then.

As a result of the above-mentioned reasons we therefore, take this opportunity to inform you that the subject is not a member of the ANC which means that we have nothing to do with him.

The Mission therefore kindly request your good office to take this case with UNHCR since the subject has been in their custody since he left the country.
