THE United States-South Africa Leader Exchange Programme (USSALEP) and the Federated Union of Black Arts (FUBA) last week completed a two-week creative workshop for 15 black South African artists.

The workshop was part of the USSALEP/FUBA incentive programme.

The artists who participated in the workshop were Ezrom Legae, Fikile Magadlela, Avhahshoni Mainganye, Kenneth Thabo, Garth Erasmus, Peter Clarke, David Mogano, Kay Hassan, Rudzani Nemasetoni, Sam Nhlengetwa, Durant Sihlali, Lefika Malope, Kagiso Mautloa, Paul Madi and Philip Malumise.

Work created during the workshop will be exhibited at the FUBA gallery from Sunday, October 6, to Friday, October, 18 in Johannesburg. It is expected to be shown in other centres at a later date.

The artist selected for the course represent the cream of black artistic

expression in South Africa.

The creative workshop was led by Peter Bradley, a graduate of the Society of Arts and Crafts in Detroit and Yale University. He has been artist in residence at Syracuse University and has taught at Franconia College, New

Hampshire.

He is presently based in New York City and has held numerous exhibitions both in the United States and Europe. His work forms part of the permanent collection of the Metropolitan Art Museum and many other leading American galleries.
