Be: Develop-ent llngelent Unit  
Following consultations Iith Hr H.Lubega and Mr H.Uisapaa  
in Hrusha on 13-11 February,1991, at Ihich the anican  
National Congress identified it's priorities and  
perspectiues for the remainder of the 4th Cycle and the  
forthcoming 5th Cycle of UNDP assistance to HLH's, the END  
herebg requests UHDP assistance with the establishment of a  
DEUELOPHENT HHHHGEHEHT UNIT. This Unit, inter alia, will  
enable the Houenent to plan and coordinate assitance from  
UN agencies and other donors.  
Duer the gears of exile the HHC's development projects have  
increased in number and scope and through UHDP assistance  
we have been able to increase the capacltg of the Projects  
and other HHC Departments to administer projects and  
generally to meet the requirements of donors. Ne refer in  
particular to the training offered for administrators and  
project management personnel.

After the unbanning of the HHC in February 1990, the Movement decided to continue with its external projects while at the same time planning its role and preparing cadres for development within South Africa. This necessitates the establishment of a Development Management Unit, based in Tanzania and comprising a core of qualified HHC project management personnel with the capacity to plan, implement and evaluate development programmes and projects. A second major task of the Development Management Unit will be to coordinate with donors, ensuring smooth bilateral and multilateral relations with regard to planning, reporting and accountability. ;

Furthermore, the Development Management Unit will enable proper coordination with HHC structures and other development actors within South Africa.

The role of UNDP and other UN agencies in a future democratic South Africa requires careful consideration and forward planning. It is envisaged that the Development Management Unit will monitor the situation and liaise closely with UNDP and other UN agencies in this regard.

The African National Congress requests the assistance of a consultant from the United Nations Department of Technical Cooperation for Development to formulate a project proposal for the establishment of the Development Management Unit.

Given the urgency of setting up the Unit we would appreciate the assistance as soon as it is feasible.

With appreciation of the HHC for UNDP cooperation and assistance to the victims of Apartheid.
