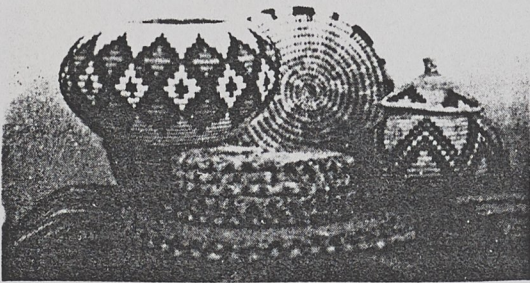

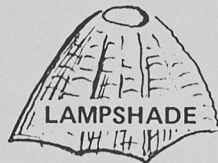


Grinder

Uggoko (Meat tray)

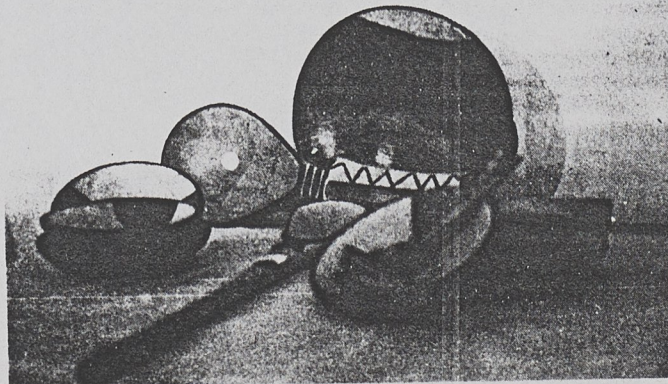

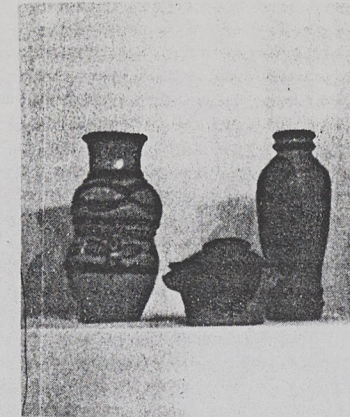
