Dear Comrade Maindy,

Following on the letter we wrote to you last time we would like to put more emphasis on the following points. These are due to the developments that have taken place since our last letter, and thus altering some significant points with regards to our lists of placements.

1. We had suggested in our last letter that you please contact the S.G. over placement of the students that you mentioned in your letter, with a view to placing them in institutions of higher learning in this current academic year. From our discussions with the S.G. it is quite clear that we cannot make any follow-up on any of the cases without recommendation from the Principal of Somafo. Thus it has become more imperative that we should consult with Somafo before we can proceed with drawing up of the final lists. We therefore recommend that the cases mentioned in your letter should have an accompaniment of the assessment of the School.
 2. We had promised to deliver to you the copies of the letter we received from the students union with regard to the placement of our student applicants in the Soviet Union. Unfortunately the letter did not have the necessary enclosures and this appeared irregular. This time we make sure that the list does accompany the letter.
 3. Another enclosure is the letter from the Czechoslovakia embassy in relation to the students who have been accepted at technical level. Our problem at present is that the decision to cancel the three comrades who were placed at UNZA for the UNDP course in building we already applied for in Czechoslovakia. By the time decision was made for the cancellation there was no time to substitute. Thus we are faced with the problem of having to withdraw them at this very late stage. Another point which causes worry to us is that this is the first major offer from the Czechs, and if we can send our regrets we will find ourselves without any offer next year. Thus since we had 10 offers for technical level and we have been able to fill only five places, then it is important that we make our letter of apology be such that the confidence in our organisation is not lost.
