Further to my recent letter to you proposing for possible dates viz. 23rd and 28th October, 1st and 6th November. almost all the invited political parties and organisations. including the main players in the National Peace Accord. have responded positively. They all agreed that the one day Consultation should be held on the 6th November 1991.

The only organisation that has not given us an indication of a suitable date 13 the ANC. We therefore request you to consider the 6th November as a date that all could meet. We also wish to propose to you a two person delegation from the ANC as the other two measure players (the NP/Government and the IF?) will send two senior people to the Consultation. This level of protocol was strongly suggested by the measure players.

On Tuesday, 22nd October I phoned your office and epoke with your secretary, Me Tlna Radebe and requested her to diarise the date as stated above for your attention.

We lnvl sage the Consultation to take place between 10Hoo and 16HDQ at Kolnonia Conference Centre, 116 Ascot Road. Cnr let Street, Judith Pearl. Johannesburg.

We would appreciate it if you could inform us who from the ANC, including yourself will be attending the Consultation.
