Minutes of Regional Political Committee meeting held March 3 1986.

1. Winnipeg Minutes were read and discussed. They contained the names of their Office-bearers, and included two applications to join the Unit. The Minutes also mentioned using Telepost for rapid communication with the Office, as an alternative to expensive phonecalls. The RPC felt that only high-priority information should be sent in this way, because of the cost. Cmde Saloojee was to write in reply, and deal also with the matters of the Somafco video (which now exists, and the Unit wanted to obtain a copy) and their requests for more copies of Sechaba. The Secretary will send the applications from M. Mitchell and I Appolis to HQ.
