The DCC is intended to answer the pressing need for an AUG Cultural Centre; as well as to serve as a comnnmity cultural centre for the Dakawa settlement. The DOC might seem elaborate at first glanoe-but we are concerned to stress its nature as a production centre .Many of the skills concerned With the DOC already existw inw our ramks, but we lack the adminstrative focus and logistical means to bring them into oporationAt the same time training and upgrading will be vital components of the DCC's success. Success in the DCC project will eetablish a. firm wltm-al revolutionazy impetus within our movement; and implemented in side South Africa. from oomrmqijy to community 9 a, firm cultural thrust in our reconstruction period.
