ANC, PAC accused of ganging up

THE ANC and PAC are out of touch with their followers' thinking by insisting on a negotiated settlement with the Government.

Former executive committee member of the Pan Africanist Students' Organisation, Mr Thabiso Raditaba, said this during the Media Workers' Association of South Africa's Southern Transvaal regional congress in Johannesburg yesterday.

Raditaba also accused the organisations of ganging up on the Azanian Peoples Organisation.

He said the ANC and PAC were uncomfortable with Azapo because of its "unwillingness to collaborate".

"That explains their ganging up against Azapo which was expelled from the Patriotic Front conference three weeks ago," Raditaba said.

He said that Azapo was right in rejecting the idea of "supping" with whites and homeland leaders in the PF conference.

He said both organisations referred to homeland leaders like Oupa Gqozo and Bantu Holomisa as patriots.

"There is nothing patriotic about these leaders. They have been discredited for collaborating with the system of apartheid," he said.

The regional executive office bearers were returned unopposed, headed by chairman Mr Tseliso Raditaba. Mr Joe Mdhlela was elected vice-chairman.

Jay Naidoo: top of the most-hated list

JAY Naidoo has ousted such formidable contenders as Winnie Mandela and Desmond Tutu as the person that many Afrikaans newspaper commentators love to hate.

A columnist in BEELD said that Winnie and Archbishop Tutu and Allan Boesak and Trevor Huddleston could all breathe easier now because there was a new "Enemy Number One" — Jayaseelan Naidoo, the architect of last week's two-day stayaway.

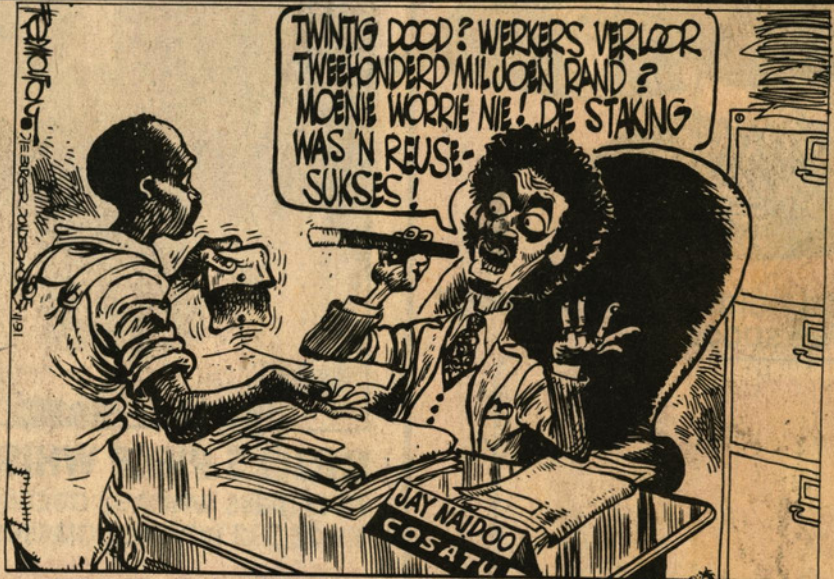
The columnist said Mr Naidoo had brought tension and confrontation at a time which cried out for reconciliation. He was a blackmailer instead of a negotiator. He had damaged the economy. And he casually dismissed the deaths which took place during the stayaway.

In an editorial, BEELD said Mr Naidoo must forget about his own ambitions and start seeing to the genuine interests of the workers instead.

"Then perhaps he will realise his claims that the strike was a success because there was no intimidation are wrong.

"In the climate of violence which people like him and the ANC have helped create in the black townships, they don't need to intimidate anyone. The fear of becoming yet another one of the thousands of people who have died is enough to keep people at home."

In sharp contrast, Max du Preez, the iconoclastic editor of VRYE WEEKBLAD, said that although quite a few people had obviously stayed at home just in case there might be intimidation, this was by no means the main factor in keeping people away

from work.

He said the lesson to be learned from the strike action was that the Government and other negotiators dare not walk over the black masses again and take decisions in their name. Confrontation and pain would continue as long as the rulers and the white establishment believed the social status quo could be quietly maintained after apartheid.

The editor was scathing about the "sudden sympathy" expressed by many whites about the lot of the black workers and about the people who died in the stayaway.

He said: "I still remember how the biggest Afrikaans newspaper in the country virtually ignored the slaughter of a dozen people on the East Rand one Saturday and banner-headlined Naas Botha's wedding or his boots or his wife's dress or something, instead."

Mayor Dinkins stays within ANC fold during his visit to South Africa

JOHANNESBURG: New York mayor David Dinkins has not met any organisation or party other than the ANC since his arrival in the country on Tuesday.

Mr Dinkins, on a five-day visit to South Africa as a guest of the ANC, has had briefings by a number of pro-ANC organisations, but has yet to meet representatives of other organisations on either the left or the right.

A meeting he had scheduled with Constitutional Development Minister and Acting President Gerrit Viljoen at the Union Building in Pretoria on Wednesday did not take place.

On the third day of his visit yesterday Mr Dinkins was taken on a tour of Phola Park where he was briefed by

local civic organisations and ANC officials. In the afternoon he paid Nobel Prize laureate Nadine Gordimer a courtesy visit at her Parktown West home.

Ms Gordimer, winner of this year's Nobel Prize for Literature, is also an ANC member.

At Phola Park yesterday Mr Dinkins pledged to focus world attention on black South Africans' living conditions, which he denounced as immoral.

The New York mayor, accompanied by about 35 aides and representatives of various US newspapers and television stations, will visit Cape Town today.

His itinerary did not indicate any appointments for the day.

Groups want new code on SA trade

THE South African Council of Churches, the South African Bishops Conference, Kagiso Trust and the Institute for Contextual Theology are planning a consultation to work out a code of investment for South Africa.

In a statement on Saturday, the SACC said the consultation - meeting under the theme "Towards a Code of

Investment: Ethics for South Africa's International Economic Relations" - would be held in February in Broederstroom.

"This will bring together representatives of trade unions, business, political organisations, as well as experts on economics, into a reflective interaction with church leaders and theologians.

"The objective of this exercise is

formulated against the background of the debates on sanctions and the reality that, despite calls for financial sanctions against South Africa to be maintained until some form of a transitional government is installed, more and more overseas companies are beginning to either invest in South Africa or are busy with preparations to do so." - *South African Press Association.*

ANC leaves huge debts unpaid

LUSAKA — The African National Congress owes Zambia a large debt. Not only has the country played host to the movement for the last 20 years or more, but when the ANC packed their bags and went home they left behind scores of bills running into millions of rands.

When it closed up earlier this year the head office of the ANC-in-exile here owed Zam-

bia's state-owned Posts and Telecommunications Corporation (PTC) alone the equivalent of about R1 million. PTC has since been paid just over a quarter of this amount.

"In addition to the ANC's composite account of 16 million kwacha, there are a many more individual members who owe us much more," said a spokesman in the accounts de-

partment of PTC. He said he was unable to give a total figure owed by ANC members.

The movement also owes large sums to the Lusaka Water and Sewerage Company, the electricity corporation ZESCO and the National Housing Authority, from whom the movement rented property. However, officials were not prepared to disclose

how much was owed.

Scores of private landlords who let property to ANC exiles are also owed large sums in unpaid rent and other bills. Many, who are themselves being sued by the utility companies, are taking legal action against the ANC.

One ANC official who has stayed in Lusaka and who declined to be named, said there

was hardly enough money to pay for the food of scores of members still living in Zambia. "It's unlikely we'll be able to pay any other bills."

Until last year there were up to 3 000 ANC members in Zambia. Most returned home earlier this year.

The former head office of the organisation has been bought by the Zambian government and will be turned into a museum of liberation movements who fought from Zambian soil.

Mandela steers clear of De Klerk-PW tape recording row

EAST LONDON: ANC leader Nelson Mandela has shrugged off an alleged row over a tape recording of his first meeting with former State President P.W. Botha, which is alleged to have developed between him and his successor, President F.W. de Klerk.

Speaking in East London en-route to Johannesburg, he said the matter was between Mr de Klerk and Mr Botha and he was "not prepared to make any opinion or point of dispute" on the issue.

He was reacting to a report in a Sunday newspaper to the effect that Mr

Botha had said he wanted to use the tape's contents in his memoirs, but that a "reliable source" had said he wanted to use it to dispel suggestions that he had set the course of reform followed by his successor.

It has been claimed that the July, 1989 meeting between Messrs Botha and Mandela laid the basis for negotiations between the ANC and the National Party.

Mr Mandela said the ANC and the NP had reached an important stage in the current "peace process" and he was not prepared to say anything that

might affect it.

He and Mr Botha had released a Press statement when they met three years ago which had mainly stated their commitment to peace in the country.

Meanwhile, President de Klerk said yesterday that the current South African reform process was a logical consequence of initiatives taken by Mr Botha.

He was speaking at a Press conference at Jan Smuts Airport on his return to South Africa from an official visit to Israel, Taiwan and Mauritius, which

also included an unofficial stop-over in Oman.

Mr de Klerk said he was doing what he thought was right for South Africa and was not hiding behind his predecessor to justify his actions.

"I believe that what I am doing is the logical consequence of what he (Mr Botha) has initiated. But he is entitled to differ on that.

"What we are doing now we believe is right for South Africa and we are not justifying that on any discussion my predecessor had with Mr Mandela".— Sapa
