Dear Comrade Nzo,

In reply to your inspiring letter dated 2nd June 1977 do we urgently wish to bring to your immediate attention the following factors:

1. In your letter, which was received with overwhelming joy by our union, is stated that the number of our delegation to our Moscow conference remains 5. This number according to your letter can be further increased by 1 or 2.

2. Before his departure from Hungary Comrade Max ensured our union that the number of our delegation will be increased from the Preparatory Committees stipulation of 3, to 4 or 5.

3. Your request directed to The National Council of Hungarian Youth for 7 train tickets to facilitate our transport to Moscow.

4. We received a letter from our Moscow Preparatory Committee, a copy of which kindly find enclosed, adhering to the initial ceiling of 3 stipulated by them.

5. At present we have 5 tickets in our possession; 3 from the Hungarian Solidarity Committee and 2 from KISZ.

Before the arrival of the letter from our Prep. Committee all our plans and activity was moulded on the secure basis of a 5 member delegation, which according to points 1, 2, and 3 we regarded as a safe estimate.

The arrival of the Prep. Committees letter upsetted our apple cart. We, therefore, urgently request your final decision on either the number of our delegation or the fate of the remaining 2 tickets negotiated for. In the meantime we will try to negotiate with the Prep. Comm., and flexibly continue our arrangements on the basis of a 5 member delegation.
