Re: Passports for Headman and Wandile Nkankula.

- (1) Please find enclosed the above-mentioned passports.
- (2) I also include Cde Mike's passport. Note that FOUR passport-size photographs plus a filled passport-form is needed. The submission of specimen signatures is proving very difficult in obtaining a travel document. This is being rejected by Prime Minister's Office for cadres just accross the border in Lusaka. Thus, I would suggest that this process must be abandoned.
- (3) In view of the fact that all T/D of cadres that end have visae attached to them, please advise if there would be problems should travel documents return (new travel documents) without visae. I presume since this is not mentioned by you that it is not a problem. If it would, please advise for all.
- (4) I should also wish to emphasise that these T/D must NOT be returned until about three weeks before expiry date. Bringing them before this stipulated time would serve no purpose in view of the fact that renewals can only be done by government if the expiry period is not more than two weeks.
- (5) For those who may, like you, have C.T.D.'s, they need not send them over but please telex the particulars over, then we would arrange with G.G. to renew the travel document via their embassy there in Stockholm or wherever
