PROJECT PROPOSAL FOR MAZIMBU GARMENT FACTORY

BACKGROUND:

During the Year 1977, The African National Congress ((ANC) of South Africa, was allocated a piece of land by the Tanzanian Government. The aim of the ANC was to build a school for the Young South Africans who fleed away from the repressive laws of Apartheid. Due to the inflow of people of diffrent ages alongside to the school, the ANC decided to established other projects which are beneficial to both the students and the community.

The Garment Factory is one of the Projects established. It was founded in 1983 through the support of the Holland Committee on Southern Africa. It was supplied with machines, cutting knives, drilling machines, cottons, buttuns, zips and office equipment.

PURPOSE OF THE GARMENT FACTORY:

The factory has three main purposes:

1). To train ANC members in the field.

2). To generate funds for the organisation.

3). To be self-sufficient.

Since the inception of the factory, training has been and it's still one of the needs. It started by training machinists, but training is also needed for the designers and other skills.

The factory is also in need of the material and other items so as to satisfy some of the objectives mentioned above e.g. To generate funds for the organisation. Uptill now, the factory has been trying to produce for the community items like sheets, uniform for school children, clothing for the community etc. It is also trying to generate funds by selling the products, but it has been at a very slow rate.

Presently, is supplied a total number of 1,500 people with diffrent items mentioned.
