Please find enclosed an account by one of the students on why he cannot go back to Mazimbu.

Since my arrival here, there has been a number of such cases. This arises mostly from children who have been given permission to visit parents, relatives etc. I suggest that this matter needs to be scrutinised closely since it appears this problem will repeat itself a number of times. We here in Maputo will be flooded with a number of people who might turn out to be a security risk.

We note that the authorities here do not want a big ANC presence. Those who visit should therefore go back where they came from immediately. We would like to be guided as to how to deal with those who do not want to go back.
