 IN ITS ATTEMPTS TO CUM THE PEOPLE INTO SUBMISSION AND RECAPTURE

 OF BOTH A CLIQUE CONTINUES TO DEEPEN. APARTHEID POLICIES UNDER
 WHATEVER GUISE ARE REJECTED BY AN INCREASING NUMBER OF SOUTH
 AFRICANS, INCLUDING FORCES FROM THE RANKS OF THE RULING BLOC
 AND THE WHITE COMMUNITY IN GENERAL. BOTH AND HIS MURDEROUS
 CLIQUE STAND ISOLATED BY THE OVERWHELMING MAJORITY OF OUR PEOPLE
 AS THE ENEMY OF ALL SOUTH AFRICANS.
 INTERNATIONALLY ANTI APARTHEID FORCES CONTINUE TO EXPEND THEIR
 ENERGY AND TO ACT IN UNITY AGAINST THE CRIME OF APARTHEID. IN
 SOUTHERN AFRICA THE FORCES OF PEACE AND SOCIAL PROGRESS HAVE
 MADE GIANT STRIDES TOWARDS SECURING PEACE FOR THE PEOPLE OF
 REPUBLIC OF ANGOLA AND INDEPENDENCE FOR NAMIBIA ON THE BASIS OF
 RESOLUTION 435 OF THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL.
 THE OCCASION OF THE 5TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE UDF BRINGS INTO SHARPER
 FOCUS THE GREAT CHALLENGES WE FACE ON ALL FRONTS OF STRUGGLE. IN
 PARTICULAR, THE AFRICAN NATIONAL CONGRESS CALLS ON ALL ANTI-APARTHEID
 AND PEACE-LOVING FORCES:
 TO DEFEND THE UDF; THE DEMOCRATIC TRADE UNION MOVEMENT AND OTHER
 DEMOCRATIC ORGANISATIONS, AND TO INTENSIFY THE FIGHT AGAINST
 REPRESSION.
 TO UNITE IN ACTION ON THE BASIS OF OUR COMMON DESIRE TO GREAT
 A FUTURE FREE OF RACISM, OPPRESSION AND WAR,
 TO INTENSIFY THE CAMPAIGN FOR A MASSIVE BOYCOTT OF THE OCTOBER
 ELECTIONS AND TO STRIKE A BLOW AGAINST THESE AND OTHER APARTHEID
 STRUCTURES AND INSTITUTIONS,
 TO HEIGHTEN OUR EFFORTS TO SECURE THE UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF
 NELSON MANDELA AND OTHER POLITICAL PRISONERS AND DETAINEES; AND TO
 SAVE THE LIVES OF THOSE ON THE DEATH RUN,
 TO WORK EVEN HARDER FOR THE ALL-ROUND ISOLATION OF APARTHEID
 SOUTH AFRICA. AND FOR INCREASED SUPPORT AND SOLIDARITY TO THE
 PEOPLES OF AFRICA, NAMIBIA AND THE REST OF SOUTHERN AFRICA.
 ON OUR PART THE LEADERSHIP AND MEMBERSHIP OF THE ANC AND THE
 PEOPLE'S ARMY, UNHESITANTLY WE PLEDGE TO SPARE NO EFFORT TO
