Karen Miller (ne Davis) was born in Pretoria on 19 July 1957. After matriculating from Menlo Park High School in Pretoria and a year at the University of Pretoria where she studied law, Karin studied Graphic Design at Pretoria Technicon for 3 years (1977 - 1979).

She started working at Metal Box in January 1980. Later that year she moved to Paton Tupper Design Studio in Johannesburg. There she did packaging design, point of sale design, illustrations and rendering.

In 1984 she joined Jansen Graphics on a freelance basis where she did mostly packaging design.

Karin has won some awards at the Annual SPADA Designers Awards. She has won a merit award for the "Hang Ten" deodorant design in 1989, for "Bakers Snax" chocolate biscuits design in 1990, and for the "Prism Chocolate" biscuit design in 1993. In 1991 she won a best award for the Haze "Natureâ\200\231s Collection" range.

From 1990 to 1992 she studied Fine Arts at UNISA. One of her sculptures and two drawings were selected for the UNISA bi-annual Student Exhibition in 1992. She received a distinction in Graphics II. Due to family and work pressure she was however unable to continue her studies in 1993. Karin has now decided to make a career directed towards painting.
