This refers to your letter of March 16th, 1987, which came up for discussion by the RPC on April 6, 1987.


The Montreal Conference "Taking Sides in Southern Africa" was organised by the Canadian Council for International Cooperation. The ANC was invited to participate in the proceedings but not co-organise it. However, if invited to co-organise such an event, the ANC usually serves in a consultative capacity.

The RPC agrees with you that Cde. Dan O'Meara's keynote address on sanctions against S.A. does not reflect the ANC position. Do note though that he was not speaking on behalf of the ANC. The remarks are personal as stated in the paper.

I am afraid, ANC Canada has not paid the \$25 fee for the forthcoming WIDF conference in Moscow since we will not be sending a delegate. The National Women's Secretariat at HQ is handling the matter and apparently a delegation is already in place.

Please inform Cde. Dee September that membership application of the five comrades she mentioned has long been approved. I understand the Manitoba Unit was formally informed. Also, an information kit on Theresa Ramashamola will be mailed to her.

Lastly, the RPC suggests that for official ANC matters you use stationery with ANC letter heads in your correspondence.
