Following the departure of some comrades on scholarship abroad a number of rooms were made available. All the same this has not remedied a long standing question concerning shortage of houses. In order to bridge the gap, the following transferences and allocations were made:

UNIT 1-3

Tollie and Glory formerly staying in D.- UP 25 have both been ~~sw~~ settled in Unit 1. Makhosazana formerly staying in the Guest House with her child are now staying in Unit 2 with Ma-Mia. Tshepo is now in Unit 3.

TABORA

Mpho, formerly residing at the Youth Centre is now with Titus in Tabora 14. Evelyn's children are still occupying her room, however, arrangements are being made with school authorities for their proper settlement. Joseph Kotane and Michael formerly staying in Dakawa are now with us in Tabora 10 and Youth Centre respectively.

DOUBLE-UP

Mr. Erickson is now settling in D-UP 15 with Gabriel. D.-UP 16 is still a problem to the Housing Officer. Arthur and Chief were moved from Tabora because of their clash with the Nkwe. However their eviction, should I call it, never satisfied either myself as a H/O, or the party affected. The authorities were rather too <sup>lenient</sup> ~~lean~~ on their part concerning this matter. Chief is now staying in D-UP 25 and Arthur in D-UP 19. Desmond is also staying with Chief in D-UP 25.
