Dear Comrade Sam.

Greetings! We are all well and hope to hear the same from you as well as the other comrades at the office. Thank you so much for your letter and all other correspondence received.

First onto some good news. My play called 'Exile', of which i had earlier sent a copy of a radio adaptation to the office, was presented as one of the seven best plays written in Saskatchewan during 1987. The event at which this momentous occasion occured was marked as the 'Saskatchewan Festival of New Plays" and was heralded at the University of Rrgina in June this year. \*\*Sincexthemy\*\* Since them, I have received numerous enquiries for copies of the script from as far afield as Montreal.

Yesterday, I received an invitation to submit the play to a University in S.A. It goes without saying that your encouragement in getting me to 'write more' has certainly contributed towards this effortand I thank you wholeheartedly.

We have recently held a unit meeting after months of inactivity and enjoying the sunshine. The Minutes will be forwaded as soon as copies have been made.

Although I have spoken to Michael about the question of his membership on a number fo occasions, he has up till now done absolutely nothing about it. You see Comrade Sam, the question is this. After Michael arrived here in 1981, I told him that it is a matter of ANC policy that members from other parts of the world arrive in Canada they submit a detailed curriculum vitae together with ampicture of themselves to the office in Toronto. Although he has given me all sorts of assurances in the past that he had complied with it in the past, on questioning him about it recently I discovered that he had been lying to me all along. Perhaps you should check your records to confirm that he had never submitted any CV.

In addition there is the question of a document which went missing while in the possesion of Michael. You will remember Comrade that after the major conference held in Zambia two years ago, we the membership received numerous documents which addressed all aspects of the Movement's life. The paers were disbursed to the membership for us to provide further input into the talks and contribute to the overall progress of the revolutionary process. The document that went missing from Michael's trust dealt with the Movement's foreign policy in regard to other governments. I asked him for this document's return repeatedly and finally reported the matter to the Chief Rep. from whom I received absolutely no response at all.

of the RPC in this regard. Personally, I find my hands very much tied in this matter. While Michael's contributions to our Unit meetings amount to nothing more than his mere presence, I am of the understanding that we require a quorum of three members to hold a unit meeting. In short, without him we cannot function as a unit.

Then there is also the question of ANTHONY van WYK. I have forwarded to the Chief Rep information about this fellow in August of this year but have as yet received no response. To state the case briefly.

Both Michael and myself knew this person in Cape Town. In fact, Michael virtually grew up with him whereas I only got to know him during 1977-8 when all three of us were involved in projects for the Churches' Urban Planning Commission in the Western Cape. The last time that I had heard about this hoodlum and during a meeting in 1980 with Comrade Reggie September when he expressed his disgust and anger that Anthony had stolen tens of thousands of Rands from the Movement and was living a life of sport cars in Cape Town.

While I was in Ontario this summer, this person and his girlfriend suddenly, (apparently without notice) surfaced in Regina. On m y return home, I discovered that he had left his girlfiend behind in this city and went on to Washington where he had an office, In speaking to Michael, he told me that there was nothing that he could do to stop these people from visiting him for three weeks . I found that Anthony had become a commodities broker for the SA government, buying and selling grain and agricultural implements. In short, he had become a sanctions buster. What further alarmed me was that I heard that these two apartheid agents had been in Paris (France) during the assasination of the late Comrade Dulcie September.

I reported the matter to the local police and they are continuing their investigations.

I asked Michael how it was possible that these people could get hold of his address and telephone numberand he said that they must've got ittfrom his relatives in S.A. According to Michael's wife he has done absolutely nothing to confirm this presumption.

Further reports indicate that Anthony is planning to open an office in Toronto. In Washington DC he operates under the name of WORLD TRADE MISSIONS and is able to buy commodities from even the Soviet Union and China.

This fellow is quite obnoxious. Recently he phoned me from Toronto saying that he had just arrived in the city and could not find accomodation anywhere. Could I be so kind as to give him the names and addresses of the people that I had met in Toronto so that they could put him and his girlfiend up? I totally refused. He said that he had got my phone number from the Sedgwicks. The man has absolutely no qualms about being a dog for the Boers and states so brazenly.

Perhaps there can be an extended RPC meeting in the near future where we can discuss these and other matters conclusively.
