Recently her mother, Mrs Eunice Kaniki, who was keeping her child whilst she had gone to South Africa passed away. Mrs D.Mohajane came back to attend her mother's funeral and also to take her child to South Africa.

The Mission therefore, kindly request you to help her by registering her child for repatriation to South Africa.
