Sheila Cussons was born of Afrikaans-Irish stock. She was trained in Fine Arts at the University of Natal in Pietermaritzburg, where she was awarded the BA degree in Fine Arts in 1941, and the HED in 1942. At the time she was married to Professor C J M Nienaber, later head of the Afrikaans Department in Pietermaritzburg.

Her first volume of poetry, *Plektrum*, was published many years later in 1971, after she had lived in London, Amsterdam and Barcelona. This work received a number of awards, including the Ingrid Jonker prize, the Hofmeyer Prize and the Eugene Marais prize.

A large part of her life was spent in Spain, as wife to a Spanish businessman, but a serious burning accident changed the course of her life and poetry. She suffered major burns when a gas stove exploded in her face, but the incident unleashed an explosion of creativity. Her twelve volumes of poetry, from *Plektrum* in 1970 to *Die Knetterende Woord* in 1990, have won her every major poetry award in Afrikaans, her home language.

Her accomplishment as a graphic artist was demonstrated in *Omtoorvuur*, a volume of her selected poetry, published on the occasion of her sixtieth birthday, which was illustrated with her own drawings and etchings. Many of her poems have been translated into other languages and a selection of her poetry, which she translated into English, was published in 1985. In addition to being a modern metaphysical poet of note, Sheila Cousins has also distinguished herself as a translator of the Latin American author, Jose L Borges.

She has received all the major literary awards for Afrikaans, including the prestigious Hertzog prize, and is regarded as the doyen of Afrikaans Literature, with a stature equalling that of D J Opperman and N P van Wyk Louw.

The University of Natal honours Sheila Cussons for the outstanding contribution she has made to South African poetry.
