# 0 Background Data

- 1.1 Teaching covers primary, secondary and an upgrading post secondary course.
  - The total average number of students expected during the 1.2 year is 450.
  - The College is in its first year presently and its equipment requirements are invariably initial stocks.
  - Donors may give material support in
    - a) actual equipment sent by air or sea, or
      - b) equivalent cash.

### Stationery needs

- 26,000 exercise books in assorted sizes varying between 50 and 100 pages. (Fx Tanzania approx. 200,000 shillings).
- 2.2 1,000 reams of ruled paper (ex Tanzania 65,000 shillings)
- 2,000 reams of duplicating paper (ex Tanzania 90,000 Shs).
- 2.4 5,000 blue ball pens (ex Tanzania 15,000 shillings).

#### Teaching Aids 3.0

- 3.1 One Criffin Mobilab (R) Model MRL 110 0 for Junior Science. Now available in Tanzania for approximately 20,000 shillings. This laboratory would be very helpful for us with no proper laboratories yet until the end of 1982.
- One Mobilab for Biology/Agriculture Model MRL-150L supplied by Griffin. Now available in Tanzania at an approximate price of 20,000 shillings. This would be a very useful demonstration trolley for us without any proper laboratories yet, until 1932
- One technimobile for wood/metal supplied by Griffin. Estimated 3.3 cost 30,000 shillings. This would be very helpful to us since we do not have well equipped workshops.
- One photo-copying machine with all accesories and photo-copy paper in large quantities.
- One overhead projector with accessories.
- One Electronic scanner for cutting of stencils for the 3.6 reproduction of materials.

- 3.7 One set of language laboratory equipment with soft materials.
- 3.8 One duplicating machine and all accessories. Price ex Tanzania approximately 15,000 shillings

#### 4.0 Furniture

- 4.1 100 desks @ 320 shillings each ex Dar es Salaam plus 100 chairs for the sum of 15,000 shillings. Total cost approximately 47,000 shillings.
- 4.2 30 wooden tables for classrooms, libraries and staff rooms.
  450 shiilings each, plus 30 chairs 215 shillings each approx.
  total cost 20,000 shillings.
- 4.3 Simple basic furniture sets for staff houses.

#### 5.0 Clothing

- 5.1 Assorted clothing for a warm tropical country for students, age ranging between 14 and 30 years, mode at about 19 years.
- 5.2 Shoes, socks, canvas shoes, sports shoes and sports stockings for both boys and girls, ages ranging from 14 30 years.
- 5.3 Sports jerseys, shorts and track suits.

#### f.0 Sports Equipment

- 6.1 Any sets of sports equipment for games like soccer, boxing, rugby, volleyball, cricket, baseball, netball etc. are welcomed.
- 6.2 Set of body building kits and equipment of any variety are equally welcomed.
- 6.3 Athletic sets of equipment for ordinary field and track events.

#### 7.0 Catering

- 7.1 Large scale cooking pots of any suitable kind for cooking for about 200 persons.
- 7.2 500 durable dinning plates and mugs.
- 7.3 Cold storage equipment like a few Deep Freezers and about 10 or less small refrigerators for use in staff quaters.
- 7.4 Reasonable sized cookers with ovens for staff houses. There could be ten of these.

#### 8.0 Transport

- 8.1 One small four wheel drive Land Cruiser or Land Rover for the use of the school office.
- 8.2 One pick-up van for use in bulk food purchases from in-land farmers for use by Catering Department.
- 8.3 One approximately 50 seater bus for use by students for sports visits, field trips and educational excursions.

- 9.0 Vocational TRaining Equipment
- 9.1 The erection of and/or equipment for a Woodwork/Joinery workshop for training of 30 students.
- 9.2 A motor mechanic training workshop for 15 students.
- 9.3 A welding and metal workshop (lower level) for the training of 20 students.
- 9.4 An electric workshop for the training of 30 students.
- 9.5 A taylor and dressmaking workshop for the training of 30 students.
- 9.6 A photography workshop to train students in photography.
- 9.7 A Secretarial course and Clerk Typist course to train students in the various office skills of Typewriting, Shorthand and Secretarial duties as well as Office machines, for 15 students.
- 10.0 Library
- 10.1 Encyclopedia in both Science and humanities, English comprehensive dictionary.
- 10.2 A variety of useful reference library books.
- 10.3 Library furnishing.
- 11.0 Laboratories
- 11.1 Erection of, and supply of basic school laboratory furniture for teaching of groups of about 40 students taking:
- 11.2 Chemistry
- 11.3 Physics
- 11.4 Biology/Agriculture
- 12.0 Other Projects
- 12.1 Erection of one or more of 2 Science blocks, estimated at about 900,000 shillings each.
- 12.2 One or more of the 6 classrooms estimated at a cost of about 700,000 shillings each.
- 12.3 One library block space area 800 sq metre at a cost of 1,400,000 shillings.
- 12.4 One dormitory unit consisting of 3 dormitory blocks consisting of a community hall, 3 bedroomed staff houses, verandahs etc. at a cost of approximately 5,000,000 Tanzania shillings.
