- A. BRANCHES OF GOVERNMENT
- A.1. THE EXECUTIVE.

The Executive of the Venda Government is composed of the Chairman and (9) nine Councillors.

The powers of the Head of Government including his funcâ\200\224 tions is to exercise control of the whole government with the assistance of his Councillors who are heads of Departâ\200\224 ment (i.e. political heads.) The Department of the Head of the Government is the co-ordinating forum with all

government departments.

A.2. THE JUDICIARY

In the Republic of Venda, the judiciary is an independent

THE LEGISLATURE

In Venda the Executive and the Legislature is the same body because members of the Executive are also responsible to make laws in the form of Proclamations in the Council of National

Unity (CNU).

THE RELATIONSHIP OF EACH OF THE ABOVE TO EACH OTHER.

In Venda there is no relationship between the Judiciary and the Executive or the Legislature. The relationship only exists

between the Executive and the Legislature being the same body.

LEVELS OF GOVERNMENT.
REGIONAL GOVERNMENT

In Venda the Regional Government is not in existence. Instead we have District Councils which are established in each of the

five districts as follows:-

THOHOYANDOU DISTRICT COUNCIL, DZANANI DISTRICT COUNCIL, VUWANI DISTRICT COUNCIL, MUTALE DISTRICT COUNCIL AND TSHITALE DISTRICT

COUNCIL.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT

In Venda the Local Governments are known as Territorial Councils established in each Tribal area. There are 28 territorial

Councils in Venda situated as follows:-â\200\224

THOHOYANDOU DISTRICT

In this district we have 5 (five) territorial councils as follows:-TSHIVHASE, MPHAPHULI, MAKUYA, MULENZHE AND TSHIKONELO.

DZANANI DISTRICT

In this district we have 3 (three) territorial Councils as follows: $\hat{a}\200\224$ -

MPHEPHU, SINTHUMULE AND MPHEPHU.

VUWANI DISTRICT

In this District there are 9 (nine) territorial Councils as follows:-LWAMONDO, TSHAKHUMA, TSIANDA, HA-MUTSHA, NESENGANI, TSHIMBUPFE, DAVHANA,

MASIA AND MASHAU.

TSHITALE DISTRICT

In this district there are 5 (five) territorial Councils as follows:-

MASHAMBA , MASAKONA, NTHABALALA, MULIMA AND MUILA.

THE ROLE, POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF TRADITIONAL LEADERS AT ALL

LEVELS OF GOVERNMENT.

In Venda the role, powers and functions of traditional leaders at all levels of Government is that each Chief (Khosi) is always a Chairman of his territorial Council and all Chiefs (Mahosi) are

- ex officio members of the District Couricil where one of the Chiefs presides as a Chairman of the District Council's meetings.

RELATION OF EACH LEVEL OF GOVERNMENT TO EACH OTHER

The relationship is that matters emanating from territorial councils are referred to a District Council for a decision.

ROLE OF POLITICAL ORGANISATIONS.

At the present moment there are no registered political organi-

sations in Venda but parties are at liberty to register themselves.

STRUCTURE AND BRANCHES OF ADMINISTRATION.

The structures and Branches of Administration of Venda are as set out in the following diagram as Annexure A.

The Authority of each of th \tilde{A} Ose administrative Branches is that in each Department, the authority is the political head assisted

by the Director-General who is the administrative head.

CONSTITUTION

The Constitution of Venda is embodied in the Republic of Venda

Constitution Act, 1979 as amended (Act 9 of 1979).

Some provisions of this Constitution had been suspended by the Proclamation which established the Council of National Unity in 1990. In this Constitution as well as in the Procl. no rights

are enshrined and the Bill of Rights is also excluded.

PROPERTY LEGISLATION.

These Acts are the same as those of R.S.A. before 13/9/1979.

Amendment of R.S.A. Act is applicable in Venda if adopted.

ECONOMIC LEGISLATION

Same as those in the R.S.A. because of harmonization.

OTHER RELEVANT LEGISLATION. Labour Act, 1982 (Act 18 of 1982)

Health Acts are the same as those in the R.S.A. if adopted.

Education Act, 1973 (Act 3 of 1973)

Marriage Legislation same as those of R.S.A. $\hat{a}\200\224$ if adopted. At the moment Venda is about to pass a proclamation which will have

an effect of recognising Customary unions as valid marriages.
