The constitution of the Student: Council provides for a general student fund which is to be managed by the Students Council treasurer. This fund has not existed in the past due to lack of finance. The function of this fund is to help cover costs of student entertainment and thus improving their entertainment. The fund will also provide pocket cash to organs of the Student Council e.g. cultural committee for the small requirements they may have. With this in mind the / Student. Council intends to open up a tuck-shop. This tuck-shop should cater for all the basic needs of the students and possibly lowering the price of some items. Since many students find their monthly allowance inadequate.

Working on the basis of initially buying a months supplies. it is calculated that the capital requirement is 110- in the region of 20 000/- Shillings (twenty thousand shillings). Part of this capital will come from the Luthuli Fund (approx. 4000). This will be paid back into the fund. We would appreciate it if the treasury would assist with the remaining 20 000-shillings. It may be paid back to the treasurer who also may hold a bazaar to help cover the cost.

At present there is a vacant room in Launda which we propose to use as a tuck-shop. We have heard that this room is intended for the storage of school equipment. I then proposed that this equipment be kept in this room next to the form III I class. This room is particularly suitable for the equipment because of the wooden shutters on the windows and its size. However, we have no alternative suitable place.
