Dear Comrade,

We thank you for your letter which we've received just after our meeting, on the 9th. We regret that the one we've planned together, which was supposed to take place yesterday evening, hasn't taken place, and we suggest that you phone our office to arrange one another as soon as possible. We would like to present to you our different activities, publications, campaigns, etc., in more details than we've been able to do in our first meeting.

PLEASE, find enclosed a formal presentation of the "Forum de la Jeunesse contre l'apartheid", of which we've mainly discussed, and to which we are very pleased to invite you and ANC Youth representatives, as we spoke of. You are invited at the whole of the Forum and, more specifically, to address the audience in the formal session we'll have on the Saturday afternoon (the 18th).

I take this opportunity to inform you that we're having a monthly demonstration in front of the Embassy, the last Wednesday of each month, at 6.15 pm, to which you are, of course, invited every time (the next one will be on the 25th).

To answer your demand about financial assistance in order to cover the cost of Dulcie's funerals, we won't be able to afford a lot, because of the big financial strains we are going through since the end of last year. At the moment, our office is run by volunteers, whom we aren't able to pay regularly... We will do all that we can.

Having in mind our talks and our common objective to get as many people and organisations as possible to support the ANC, may we tell you that we are embarrassed by one aspect of the thing : that you are asking organisations to contribute, which have not been at



all involved in the setting of the funerals, some of them having even been barred from paying their tribute to Dulcie. This will complicate the whole matter, and to clear it, we still think that one of the best way would be to have a common meeting between you and the organisations in question, which associated themselves to the common letter we sent to you on the 19th, asking for such a meeting to take place.


