Subject - Request for Equipment

As you are aware, the African National Congress (SA) has a wide programme in its fight against apartheid and racial discrimination in South Africa.

It is ominterest to develop the programme of closer co-operation with UNESCO for the realisation of the mutual aims.

Our programme of co-operation can be summarised in the provision of assistance to the ANC in the form of

- (1) Supply of written material (books) on racial discrimination and the problems of South African in general.
- (2) The printing of material where an ANC will supply necessary manuscripts.
- (3) Provision of equipment, particularly in the form of a printing press for the continued publication of material in certain topics to be agreed upon between ANC and UNESCO.
 - (4) Study tours by senior members of the ANC for preparation of specialised materials.
- (5) Support personnel, particularly clerk typists to help in them projects.
- (6) The employment of UNESCO sonsultants for the organisation of seminars on eg. literacy campaign.

 A detailed request will be forthcoming soon.

At present we are in grave need of four typewriters for the purpose of our programme in difusion of information to combat apartheid.
