Dear Marjatta,

They are all supposed to be going off to Sweden on Friday though we are still having endless problems with Ike's and Robert's visas - somehow it is the women who have sorted themselves out.

I do hope that you are well and since I understand that you are to leave SOMAFCO at the end of the year, I wonder how you feel about that. No doubt it is a heavy workload but just being in Africa will be something I imagine you will miss.

I hope we will have an opportunity to see you, perhaps on your way through London.

I am enclosing Felicity's ticket which you will require for reclaiming her fares.
