

said the Z-squads had initially been formed by the Bureau for State Security (BOSS), and the project was then taken up, and perfected, by the National Intelligence Service.

Belgian, French and United States intelligence officers based in Paris say the NIS is a highly efficient body and almost entirely autonomous. Its leadership and personnel are considered extreme right-wingers.

"We believe the NIS often uses its Z-Squads without clearing their actions with the Government first," an informed intelligence source said.

The claims came in the wake of a dramatic escalation of the "secret war" against the ANC - including the recent assassination of Mrs Dulcie September and the attempted assassination of Professor Albie Sachs, as well as the SADF raid into Botswana.


