Complaints :- Left Sided Chest Pains
- Numbness of the Left Arm.

Present History- The patient was alright till 1972 when he first experienced Chest pains usually following a heavy meal. Pains are periodic and are situated on the left Hypochondrium and are associated with a fatty diet, and radiate to the left arm and shoulder. The patient has history of having had a mild Stroke with a loss of Speech and a unilateral paralysis of the left side: BELL'S PALSY. This was however effectively treated in Lussaka. He has no history of Night sweats or paroxysms. The patient has been on Tabs Lasix 40mg daily and Tab. Nitroglycerine PRN.

Past History- He was on many occasions been admitted in hospitals for the same problems

Social/Family History- A married man with Children, does not smoke but drinks

On Examination. Satisfactory general condition
Satisfactory nutritional status
Not pale, not jaundiced
Afebrile 37.0°C BP - 120/90 mm Hg. Pulse 76 beats

Cardio-Vascular - Heart beat on the 5th intercostal space
- I & II heart sounds normal
- No additional sounds

Respiration - - Chest symmetrical, Lungs are clear.
- No basal crepitations

Abdomen - - Soft, non tender
- Liver, spleen and kidneys not palpable.

Genitalia - - Normal male genitalia

MUSCULO-SKELETAL - No congenital Abnormalities

Nervous System - Responds to a spoken word.
