Dear Comrade Stanley

RE: LOSS OF ANC GOODS FROM DAR-ES-SALAAM HARBOUR

We are in receipt of a copy of your letter to the Executive Secretary of the OAU Liberation Committee, dated 27 March 1987, in which you pointed out some irregularities in the clearing of our goods. I agree with the manner in which you have written the letter: sharp, to the point. I don't think we can rest until these materials have been retrieved. The matter is even more serious considering that an official of the Tanzanian government could engage in such callous indisciplined behaviour when dealing with a liberation movement.

Last time I was in Dakawa, I noticed that the foundations of our stores had already been laid, but that work could not continue because the missing containers were carrying the steel to be used for the construction of the stores. I have no doubt that that container has gone the same way as the one that was previously lost at the harbour which contained the steel beams for Mazimbu.

I can only urge you to follow up this matter until our goods are recovered.
