## MINUTES OF THE 10th ANNIVERSARY PREP COMMITTEE.

25th JULY 1989.

#### AGENDA:

The minutes were adopted with the following corrections:

- the group's name is Operation Dagwerk and it is a Nordic group.
- the identification of members of this committee should be uniform. The Director prefers to be called Cde Manghezi or Cde Deputy Chairperson.

### Matters arising:

- Cde Babu is not well and has delegated Cde Ntaba to represent him.
- Cde Njobe has not been attending for a long time and has to be contacted and asked to attend.

Budget - this subject would be dealt with under the agenda item correspondence

- Publicity Tshepe and Lungi are responsible for the studio and should be contacted in the absence of Donga.
  - the idea of the brochure fell along the wayside
  - there should be co-ordination of the written material giving information about the exhibition.

### Culture

- the sub-comm on culture has now been formed.
- the Primary school is ready and just waiting to be told where they feature in the programme.
- there is an idea from the secondary school to compile an anthology of students' poetry.
- they will be ready to also present choral verse.
- the band is practising. It has some problems with the equipment but this is nothing major.
- the Pioneers are ready to form a guard of honour, drum majorettes for the occassion.
- Tebogo was away so there was no report from wat sports
- Dakawa was not represented so the situation there was unclear.
- the secondary school had 3 plays and indlamu, gumboot, recital.
- it was agreed that the implementing committee should sometimes go to rehearsals to see what is happening.
- Lux's matter was now dropped.
- the needs list of the culture people should be given to the implementing committee to attend to.

#### Sport

- The football association wanted to know what the prep committee expects them to do.
- the implementing committee was advised to deal with the different

- sports groups individually.
- the boxing association wanted to know what they were expected to do.

  It was agreed that they should give us a demonstration.
- Athletics, the schools will be responsible for this item.
- PMO the meeting with the Chief Rep did take place, and he reported that the Tanzanian govt responded positively
  - they have offered us transport for our leadership and VIPs
  - they have promised to take responsibility of the accommodation of our visitors in Dar
  - they have accepted our list of visitors for clearance
  - things are working out in terms of co-ordination with the Chief Rep's office.
  - the Chief Rep has to be asked to attend these meetings and if he cannot, we should leave it to his discretion to ask someone from his office to attend.
- Correspondence background was given on the three telexes the Birector was asked to send to HQ. He said he had sent them.
  - a reply was telexed that funds had been transferred from London to Dar
  - Cde Deputy Chairperson was to send an urgent message to HQ enquiring whete Alain was.
  - Cde Choabi did not come as was expected. Cde Mabandla would be coming of Friday. Maybe he had some message for the Prep Comm.
- ZPC branches there was a suggestion that the flag be raised at the beginning of the occassion and be left on in the fashion of the Pioneer Camp, to be lowered on the last day of the calebrations.
  - arrangements should be made with the relevant people, maybe Mabhongo with the Pioneers.
  - the community should be commended for cleanliness but also encouraged to do more.
- Accommodation there was a suggestion that houses should be reserved for our comrades coming for this occassion.
  - there was also a suggestion that we should form an environmental committee.
  - another suggestion was that the guide system which was used by the Pioneer Comm during the Camp should adopted for this occassion.
  - suggestion that the number of bicycles around should be minimised.
  - suggestion that we discuss how to improve SOMAFCO.
  - suggestion that we discuss the security of our visitors and general security. This should be raised with the branches.

- Dakawa a report was received from the Implementing Committee that Dakawa had organised itself into street committees in order to facilitate the cleaning of the area.
  - there was a suggestion that somehow we need to find a way of organising the Mazimbu community.
  - it was agreed that all the political structures in the place should be mobilised to cleam Mazimbu.

# Maintenance - we were informed that much progress has been made in the

- Social Centre. Doors are now fitted, panes will follow soon.
- Maintenance Department was working hand in hand with the Branches.
- work was in progress to get one side of the tennis court ready by the time of the occassion.
- the guesthouse was in line for renoveation.
- it was suggested that the office was in a bad state and that something should be done about it. This matter is complicated.
- the Chief Rep and the Treasury should be contacted in this connection. Cde Manghezi to write to the Chief Rep. Jimmy, Cde Manghezi and Ques to see Treasury about it, on 26.7.'89.

# Transport - the situation in this area was reported to be nil still.

- there was a suggestion that Cde Tebege and a member of the Implementing Comm should go and get a requisition from Manamela and take it to Cde Kaya. This parts would be bought as soon as possible.

Exhibition - Co-ordination is taking place.

Technical - things under control

Need to have information regarding routes and venues a.s.a.p.

Catering - the catering sub-comm will consentrate on our visitors and the community should take care of itself. It should be emphasised to the community that they are the host and they should carry themselves in that manner.

- the deputy catering officer should be identified. Cde Natso had suggested Cde Gege should be.
- catering people to be selected. The sub-comm should give the number of beasts they think should be slaughtered.
- A.O.B. there was a suggestion that a present should be given to Mwalimu after his speech.
  - information should be sought regarding sitting positions
  - Cde Mandela's bust should in place by the time of the occassion.
  - Dakawa suggests their Pioneers to involved in the occassion
  - Dakawa to prepare a budget.
  - Students have taken initiatives to decorate the school with drawings and paintings.
