Many thanks for forwarding to me copies of minutes of meetings you have held over the past months. I am sorry that because I did not have a proper address for last Sunday's meeting I was left stranded in Montréal. As you know, it is not always possible for me to attend meetings in Montréal. My work at university, my activities on behalf of anti-apartheid groups at Bishop's University, my work with the Free South Africa Committee, and my new activities with the Sherbrooke Coalition of Anti-apartheid groups, all argue against regular attendance in Montréal. There is much work to be done in the Eastern Townships and I intend to put my energy here. I shall, however, be pleased to meet informally with you and Chengiah whenever I am in Montréal. And if you so wish, I shall be pleased to receive copies of minutes of meetings that you may hold.

I wish to correct two items in the minutes. I did not suggest that we make a speaking tour of Québec to "familiarise all those concerned with A.N.C.". This suggestion in fact came from Chengiah Ragaven. I did not say I wrote a letter to Peter Bunting of the RPC in Toronto concerning your membership nor did I request the speeding-up of full membership. Please correct these items at your next meeting.
