- 1.0 Minutes of 02/02/89 were adopted.
- 2.0 Matters arising.
- 2.1 Copies of the memorandum of the CEO to the NEC and NEC Dakawa delegation Report to be circulated to all members of the Task Force
- 2.2 A brief discussion on the state of affairs in Dakawa/East Africa was opened, but it was made clear that the Task Force task was to implement and not debate over the wisdom of the NEC Directive.
- 3.0 Formation of sub-committees(see minutes of 02/02/89 for reference).
- 3.1 The CEO and cde J.Selebi were assigned the task of working out the personnel for all Task Force sub-committees.
- 4.0 Phase of transfer.
- 4.1 The case of students/pupils was brought for discussion, and it was agreed that;
 - a) All Secondary School pupils shall be affected by the transfer to continue with studies in SOMAFCO.
 - b) In case of University/College students, cases shall be treated on own merits.
 - c) Dept. of Education is to freeze the granting of secondary level scholarship.
- 4.2 Cde Awolo should be requested to provide the Task Force with a list of Mouses(addresses) to facilitate the transfer.

Furthermore, he shall be kept posted with the developments of both two phases of transfer so as to make prior inventory of houses before the transfer.

- 4.3 The Task Force shall, after it had gone through all the necessary preliminary preparations, set a target date to effect phase one of the Directive.
