JUNE 26 IS SOUTH AFRICA FREEDOM DAY. ON THIS DAY SOUTH AFRICANS REDEDICATE THEMSELVES TO THE STRUGGLE TO BRING ABOUT FREEDOM AND LIBERATION AGAINST THE EVILS OF APARTHEID.
