Dear Comrade,

At the first meeting of the Inaugural Committee of the Regional Treasury Morogoro-Mazimbu held on 25.2.81, I was requested to bring the following matters to your attention.


1. This Committee feels that the Medical Committee should requisition for medical supplies in the same way as all other sub-committees in order that proper records can be kept by the Treasury.

2. It was reported that medicines, drugs, bandages, gauze, etc., are not always properly stored, being often subjected to rain, rat infestation, and so on, and that this requires urgent attention.

3. Agreed that medicines and drugs that are stored for long periods became unusable. (This is often due to lack of storage space.) That Headquarters be asked if such drugs and medicines can be donated to the Morogoro Hospital who provide free medical treatment for ANC comrades. It was generally felt that an unfavourable impression could be gained by visiting donors to Mazimbu, should they notice such stocks being wasted.

A copy of this letter has been forwarded to Headquarters.
