treated 2 315 adults and 237 children. 1 139 of the adults were Tanzanian workers on the Mazimbu project and peasants from surrounding villages. The most prevalent disease is malaria. Many patients also suffer from respiratory infections and septic sores. Unfortunately shortage of staff has postponed the utilisation of some of the hospital facilities. The in-patient section, operating theaters and dental surgery still have to be commissioned. From the outset, the Mazimbu medical team has relied heavily on the support and cooperation of the Tanzanian medical services. These services provide free medical treatment to ANC personnel. In the past, all serious cases were referred to the Morogoro or Dar es Salaam hospitals. We still rely on the Morogoro Hospital for cases where ward care is required.

The treatment of mental illness remains a problem. The stress of life in apartheid South Africa, coupled with the stress of living away from one's own country, together with the trauma of detention and torture, (the fate of many) have had their effect on some of the Mazimbu community. We are fortunate to have the services of an ARC psychiatrist from Norway who is to visit Mazimbu once a year.

Insufficient trained medical personnel and shortages of drugs, sometimes chronic, remain the chief problems in the field of health care.
