
SIZWE GUMEDE.

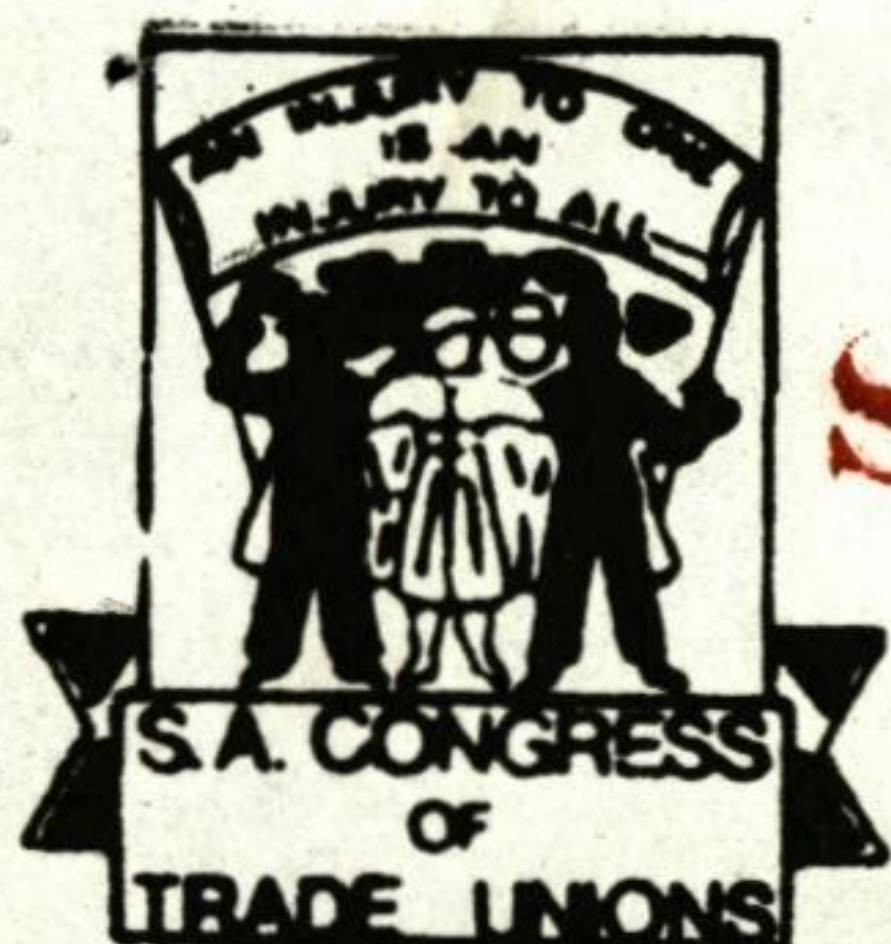


Dear Comrade Nzo
