I am a member of the A.N.C. from Chesterville branch  
Durban.

My names are CECIL BENJAMIN NDULI. At present I am here  
in Swaziland. I came into Swaziland during the year 1964  
31st March. I presented myself to the Executive Committee of  
which was headed by Dr. W.Z. Conco and Mr. Mandla Sithole as  
the secretary.

I gave my report. I also informed them of the situation  
at home, plus the picture of the organization at home.

I was detained during the 90 days detantion. So whilst I  
was inside, I saw what was going wrong which was ill for the  
organization. So when I was out I made it a point to inform  
the organization. We worked very hard to rebuild the Durban  
Region and also to persuade Mr. Elias Kunene late Alison  
Kanyile and Mr. Selborn Maphonya. To go out of the country so  
that they may avoid to give evidence against some members of  
the organization e.g. Mr. M.B. Yengwa, Albert Dlomo, Fred  
Dube etc.

In short Mr. Maphonya agreed to leave for Basotholand (by  
than) Mr. Khanyile promised us that he will not give evidence.  
So Elias said he will go if I was to come with him. Then the  
organization asked me to accompany him to Swaziland. I agreed  
so here I am. I had been here in Swaziland ever since.

During 1967, there was some misuse of funds by some executive  
members and some segregating in giving some money. I was among  
those who were not given this money. So we came together to  
correct this wrong which was going on.

I was among the top leaders in this action. The outcome  
of this action was good. The members were once more re-united.

I was made to understand that I was suspended because I was ignorant of the A.N.C's Policy. That was a ruling from M.B. Yengwa. I was shocked because I was not a new member. I grew up in the A.N.C. I was in the secretariate of Durban Region. I was the secretary of Chesterville branch and executive member of the youth League (before it was burned). Natal province I am isolated as from that day to the present day.

I had seen Com. Moses Mabeda Albert Dlomo, I had written many letters to the local executive committee of the A.N.C. so far nothing has happened.

I receive no help from the organization. But I had helped many freedom fighters financially and morally.


Sir, I am writting this letter to inform you that you may help me. I am married with eight children to support. I am not employed.
