



A delegation of Danish parliamentarians and DCA is planning a visit to Namibia at the end of August and beginning of September. The visit is a follow-up on a visit, which should have taken place last year.

The delegation will go to Lusaka on its way home from Namibia for meetings with the leadership of ANC.

The visit was discussed with Mr. Thabo Mbeki during a visit in Copenhagen end of last month, and it was agreed with Mr. Mbeki that the meetings with the delegation should be planned in details during Mr. Aron Mnizi's stay in Lusaka end of July.

For the delegation it is important to meet with the * leadership of the ANC and the people working in programmes and projects, which are receiving funds from Denmark. For a long time the Danish Government and DCA have been involved in funding ANC programmes.

Enclosed you will find a list of members of the delegation and the programme for the visit in Namibia. The delegation will arrive in Lusaka on 8th September at 17.30 and will leave Lusaka on 9th September at 18.55. The delegation will be staying at Pamodzi Hotel in Lusaka.

VISIT TO NAMIBIA FOR DANISH PARLIAMENTARIANS

Aim of Visit: - is to provide the group of parliamentarians with first-hand impressions of the situation in Namibia especially in regards to:

- visiting projects and programmes supported by Danish funds
- meeting representatives for the political parties, trade unions and economic life
- meetings with UNTAG, UNCHR
- meetings with the Danish UN forces
- meetings with South African officials

Tentative programme

1st day: By air to Namibia via London and Johannesburg.

2nd day: Visits and meetings in Windhoek.

Briefing about the present situation and conditions in Namibia by the churches, UNTAG, UNCHR, the human rights organisations among others.

3rd & 4th day: Visit to Ovamboland, visits to projects supported by Danish funds, i.e. schools, human rights center, clinics, and repatriation of refugees.

5th & 6th day: The delegation visits various areas.

7th & 8th day: Meetings in Windhoek with political parties, SWAPO, DTA, trade unions, businessmen, UNTAG, UNCHR, the Danish UN forces.

9th day. Return to Copenhagen via Johannesburg, Lusaka and London.
