Due to renovations at our local clinic and the attendant disruption his medical records have been misplaced.

The matter is of utmost urgency as the comrade is in constant pain and, though resilient and brave, is under growing psychological stress due to the disfigurement.

Your speedy intervention to assist in this matter will most appreciated and we are certain that our appeal will meet with the usual sympathetic and positive response that is characteristic of the VDJ.
