:- JC is taeching 25 periods perweek . He cannot organise material,mark
work or prepare lessons properly while sharing a single room.
- There are 7 of us in the house.Also , having to live in a single
room is very uncomfortable and inconvenient.
, JC has to have the Social Science library. He cannot organise it
in his present accomodation. The students are suffering,(although
some books have been distributed to the form Vs.)
B :- We have nothing to say against cdes Lucy and Dinah, except that
living with both OR EITHER of them would cause serious problems :
- Cde Lucy is matron of the Primary school.This means there is
a lot of movement through the house - including the kitchen 1:
- Both cdes Lucy and Dinah are sickly. We do not feel we are in a
a position to take care of them.(We shall both be working full-
time from therend of May)
- Having the Social Science library means we shall often be visitd
by students. We need a quiet, orderly atmosphere so JC can give
them books and advice. The books need to be secure.The house is
far from quiet, especially on weekends, for well-known reasons.
- We have been told that the reason we have to live in the house
(and not , for example, in double-up) is that there is a rule
that teachers must live near the dormitories. Apart from the fact
that many teachers live far from thedormitories - it is clear
that Brimarx school teachers should live in unit one.
C : We would like to make the following suggestions :-
1) Consider making a double room available in " double -up". We
f?ggl our case is urgent and needs a flexible approach.
It wiould only take the Secondary students 3 extra minutes b
get to us in " double - up". Alternatively , we would of
course be prepared to live naer the school provided conditions
in the house allow us to live and work properly.
2) In the meantime, at least make allocate us two single rooms
one of which can accomodate the social science library and
be a working area for JC to prepare lessons, etc.
