b. and d. London. Studied in London and in Berlin. In 1916 came to South Africa. 1921-4 — Keeper of the Michaelis Collection, Cape Town, 1924 married the South African painter, Stratford Caldecott. Represented in major public collections. Colour, order and boldness are features of her style. Late work tends to be restrained and somewhat melancholy.
