There is also a risk of pregnancy betwwun the time a case is seen by a general medical practitioner and the, date of insertion of a loop (about 3 - 6 weeks) by a gynaecOIOgist.

Tuberculosis suspects are investigated by a clrnic doctoi_ and prescribed for is positive.

These casee are then transferred to Dar-Es-Salaam where they will have a balanced diet which is necessary for their recevary, and which Naputo cannot afford. Epilettice are prescribed for an the strength of their histories by clintt do tore as there are no E.E.G. technicians.

Psycosis cases are also referred by clinic teeters to Psychiatric clinics er wards.

The period: between reference and examination of cases are rather long and I have to sedate patients in the interim with valium.

Patients from other residencessend calls to the clinic and are treated as domicile cases for security reasons, except those who need doctors attention.

MAAOHA: This is forty five miles away. A medical kit with written instructions is prepared for this area, and is replenished if and uhen necessary. This is a very vital sensitive area.
