

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

Dear Mervyn:

As you know I am a board-eligible family physician and my wife is a nurse-midwife. We are seeking work in East Africa which would provide us both the opportunity to do a combination of direct patient care and clinical teaching. We would ideally like to work in a socialist country with a health service, or in the process of setting one up. We understand that Tanzania may be in need of health care personnel with skills such as ours.

My training is broad in that I did my undergraduate medical training at a very traditional, academically oriented institution and the bulk of my postgraduate training at a small community hospital. My clinical experience, both in training and since, includes a good deal of obstetrical and neonatal work. I am trained to do Cesarian sections and am comfortable backing up midwives. Due to the Asian, Mexican and Central American immigrant populations I served during my residency training I have some practical acquaintance with tropical diseases. I am well aware of the technical and political problems which face Third World countries as they try to improve their standards of health.

My wife lived in Kenya, while a student at the University of Nairobi, in the early 1970's and has long been interested in returning to East Africa. As you can see from her resume she has a longstanding interest in the political problems facing East Africa and is a well trained, experienced midwife.

Our economic needs are modest; I have an educational debt to repay but it is not overwhelmingly large. We have two small children whom we are attempting to raise with simple material expectations.


We would appreciate your help in making contacts that might lead to a suitable position. We anticipate making at
