A feasibility study is still being done on linkage of the farm
with Bintield Park Dam and upgrading irrigation.
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Subsidies for Universig Labourersl Houses and Ciskei (par 3.1.1.1) Mr J oubert reported that the Farm Committee felt that the assessed cost of R600 000 was now too low, and requested that the matter be referred to Building Committee for re-assessment. Item also to remain on this agenda pending possible re-incorporation of Ciskei into RSA. Categogy D

Items at present on the priority list which are regarded as of little importance at this stage.

- a) New Science Workshop if a building becomes vacant the two workshops could be consolidated for convenience.
- b) Computer Centre should preferably be away from Chemistry Laboratories. .
- c) A Science Centre was still in the planning stage. Some funding had been provided by the Dutch Government and the Centre would be named after the late Chancellor, Oliver Tambo.
- d) A computer learning Centre for high school children and adults is also being planned. Four companies were interested in giving equipment and servicing free of charge.

Post of Universig Planner (par 3.2)

A report from the sub-committee appointed to investigate the post was tabled and discussed. -

Proposal

The post of University Planner would be considered as that of Academic Planner, and the re-creation of the University Planning Unit would also be considered, to plan and co-ordinate the short and long-term development of the University in both the Academic and physical fields. With the potential for grth we have, and the need for a broad-based expansion in Tertiary education, this Unit could provide a valuable service.

The University Planning Unit should thus consist of the Academic Planner and the University Architect (Physical Planner), and the SAPSE Officer. The committee approved the above proposal. The post of Planner to be at the same level as that of the previous incumbent, or higher. The previously appointed sub-committee would work out a detailed job description, with reporting relationships etc. It was noted that EXCO had approved the creation of a post of Human Resources Officer; this could possibly be included in the job description.

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The committee was thanked for their work in producing the report. "

Change of Name of Department of Soil Science and Plant Protection to Agronomy (par 3.2.2) "

Still awaiting approval by Ciskei Department of Education. Noted.

CU Hall - Faculty of Theology (par 4.1)

MI Bellad-Ellis had submitted costs of work needed to convert the hall for academic use to the Theology Faculty.

Faculty would draw up a proposal for overseas funding, for the conversion, and Mr Bellad Ellis would provide suitable sketch plan in liaison with the Faculty. Re-housing of History Department (par 4.2)

Noted that the HOD of History was on study leave at presentt-Faculties of Arts and Education to carry on with their negotiations.

Security in Faculty of Education (par 4.3)

Mr Bellad-Ellis was to investigate costs of electronic alarm systems. He reported that cost could be R3000 - R3500 per room.

The meeting agreed that Mr Bellad Ellis obtain quotations for a security system for the whole university. Responses from Faculties would be required for this investigation. Matter to be referred to Building Committee for EXCO.

Change of Name of Department of Curriculum Studies and Didactics to Curriculum Studies (par 5.1)

Approved by Senate, EXCO and Council. Referred to Ciskei Department of Education.
