We left immediately to Dakawa after that.

On Sunday the 28th of September, 1986, I got a lift from comrades Martin and David, it was at about 9.00 hrs in the morning. I was at the guest house when they were going to town I stopped them and alked for a lift, and as I got in the car I remembered that I had forgotten my permit, so I asked my younger brother to bring it for me. Insteat of bringing the permit he brought the whole envelope to me, I did not give him back since Martin was in a hurry to take some comrades to the bus station (they were going to Dar), and that explains as to why the envelope was in the car.

We dropped the comrades at the bus station then went to see comrade Bentry we picked him up and went to a party in front of Sapna. At the party we had two beers each, then came home at about 9.15 hrs (p.m).

When we reached the gate we were told to park the car in the process I forgot the envelope in the car. That is what happened on Sunday the 28th of September, 1986.

I came from Dakawa on Friday the 26th 09. 1986 t collect the monthly wages and the Mia Mojas for Dakawa.

On arrivalg I was told that I would get them on Tuesday the 30th of September 1986.

And when we reached Bentry's place Martin and David were sent to get some honey beer while I waited for them there they got a few then we went to the party which only started at about 6.00 p.m.

re: DAVID (What happened on the 4th of October 1986)

At 3.30 pm I went straight to Luanda and I stayed in Luanda up to 10pm In Luanda I was together with Bizzah, Martin, Joyce, and Themba. Themba and Joyce left us at about 9.15 for Youth Centre. I left Luanda at 10.00pm to go and collect my earphone, when I arrived at the Youth Centre I found my reemmate Metsamai who is working at the Farm. Cde, Leberu arrived at the time and told us that comrade Victor was hit by a stone but is not known who hit him .I laughed at the matter because I thought it was a joke. Later on Harold told us that Victor was hit by a stone.I did not comment at the time. AT the time of the incident I was not even at the Youth Centre I did not injure Victor and I never had any quarrel with him, although some people are under impression that I did it. At one time I did threaten Mphe and told her that one of us will die i.e. myself, herself or Victor.

I was inlove with Mphe before but Victor took over I did not intefere with their affair. There was no need to quarrel over a girl.

I questioned her about it before but she kept on telling that Victor was just a friend and I told her that that type of friendship does not satisfy me. I called both of them many times to talk it ever. Mpho aa told me that we better part and I agree. I told British about the whole affair. When was also present at the time.

On a certain day I decided to take acid from the Carage with the intention to go straight to Mpho's place. The reason was that I intend to destroy the elethes which I gave her e.g. canvass shees. When I got to her place I found her outside with a bucket full of clothes I threatened to throw the acid at her and she blocked with her baby. I then throw the acid on the clothes in the bucket, I told her that I did not care I could go to Betswana. She was wearing a skime at the time and nor a bermuda as she claimed. I discussed it with Mpho semetimes after the incident. I wrote a letter to Betswana and I even told Mercedes who is in Zambia at present asked for clothes to repleced Mpho's clothes. T The incident happened about a month before the Education Conference. At the time I was working at the Carage.
