'Witnesses fear giving evidence Sexwale B UNDA FtULASHE and J OUTE GOLDING BOIPATONG restdenu had refused to give statements to the police on the recent massacre because of "profound mistrust of the police and security forces". the Goldstone Commission was told yesterday. In a strongly warded memorandum pteeented to the commission on the fuel day of the inquiry into the Botpetong massacre, African National Congress PWV chairman Tokyo Sexwele else said it was not "the hand that disembowelted the Itine-rnonth pregnant woman that day" but the forces behind the attack which shoutd be emphasised. namely the police and the state.
