Dear Comrade,


Further to telex TA55 dated March 14, 1979, which I delivered to your Office, I wish, on behalf of the Executive Secretary of the Economic Commission for Africa (ECA), Prof. A. Adedeji, to confirm our invitation to your movement to be represented at the fourteenth session and fifth meeting of the ECA Conference of Ministers to be held in Rabat, Kingdom of Morocco, from March 20-30, 1979.

Unfortunately I am not able to give you any background document because the limited copies that were sent to our Office are all out of stock now. But these will be made available to your delegate in Rabat. I am hoping by tomorrow I will have reproduced the agenda which I shall pass on to your Office.

We are paying travel and subsistence for your delegate; I have accordingly instructed the Zambia Airways to issue an economy class return ticket Lusaka Rabat to a person you will name as your delegate. If your delegate is based in London we shall similarly instruct Zambia Airways to issue a return ticket London-Rabat-London. I shall be grateful therefore if you would let me have the name of your delegate as soon as possible so that we can arrange to have his subsistence paid. If he is based in London he will get his per diem in Rabat from our conference Officer.

Your delegate will have to start travelling on March 17 (Saturday) from Lusaka at 21.30 hours by QZ 706 to Rome and Paris from where he will make a connection to Rabat on March 18 (Sunday).
