Note of a Meeting held at the  
South African Embassy

6 July 1993

Present: His Excellency Kent Durr - Ambassador

Dr Butler outlined the history of LMT and our present  
funding problems.

The Ambassador saw a problem of whether his Treasury  
would be able to fund students out of South Africa either  
for first or second degrees. There was also the\$  
experience of those who did not then return home.

However, he accepted that the LMT problem was that of  
funding existing students to complete their courses and  
that this was a residue of the history of South Africa  
that needs to be addressed.

He undertook

- to follow up the matter internally;
- to raise the matter with the British Government who he  
was seeing on 9 July.

Cash requirements

Students are sponsored in United Kingdom, USA, Canada, Sweden and South Africa. The cost of those in South Africa is covered by funds from the Swedish International Development Authority and it is hoped such funding will continue until their courses are completed.

The problem of funding in the Northern hemisphere is now acute. Some measures have been taken to alleviate the position, including

- the British Council accepting some students on their books;

- the United Nations covering the fees of some students. The remaining requirements are

funds received 110,000

current deficit 272,000

Notes

- 11 students due to complete first degrees in 1993 have requested a one-year extension to take a second degree.

Estimate in above figures: 31,000

- no provision is made for student transport to South Africa.

They have been requested

to register with UNHCR;

- no provision for administration costs, say \$50,000 in 1993.
