'Front' bulletin urges pupils to 'spread racism'

A HATE-FILLED racist bulletin is being circulated by the National Front in hundreds of copies among schoolchildren in London's East End.

Called Bulldog, it is the first poisonous fruit to emerge from the formation a fortnight ago of the "Young National Front." A copy came into the Star's hands vesterday.

Describing itself as a "free nonthly," and "organ of East ondon Young National Front," s five pages contain a torrent of buse and insults against black cople and "the reds."

It urges its readers to "spread e racialist word."

Teachers at four of Barking's 11 comprehensives — which are attended by some black students — have protested to Barking Community Relations Council that the sheet has been circulated first openly, and now clandestinely, among pupils while at

Two statements in Bulldog have been forwarded by Barking CRC to the Attorney-General for an examination of whether they contravene the 1976 Race Relations Act.

In one of these statements, young black "assailant," alleged without evidence to have robbed and kicked a white woman and run away, is referred to in these words:




A four-strong deputation delivered the Scottish petition to the Scottish Secretary of State's private secretary in Edinburgh yesterday.


