WE NEED TO KNOW THE NAMES OF 30 CHAIRPERSONS  
AND SECRETARIES OF 30 DISTRICTS

It is proposed that:

- a. An important person visit districts
- b. the names of candidates who will accompanying this important person and address meetings at these 30 districts. Will have to known and cleared.

0. Who the persons accompanying the important person pass on to the next district.

- d. the District Chairperson & Secretaries continue to distribute election material at the place where the important person has already addressed meeting. The material include affidavit forms, voting cards, and also conduct ANC election propaganda work.

In this task they will be assisted by the local district Executive Committees when will in turn set up management to supervise the volunteer teams who will be following in the footsteps of those who will have addressed the mass meetings. These teams will be provided with the following material:

1. Voter Education kits to be provided by Matla Trust which kits will be passed on to us for the purpose of the implementation of the process to give this education.
2. Affidavit forms which will be used to help the villages where they have not been timeous preparations by the local chief. These affidavits, the villagers where such persons are unable to read or write and taken by the applicant to the chief for his signature an lastly presented by applicant to a magistrate who will be expected to provide the applicant in exchange of this affidavit, a voters cards on polling day to cast his/her vote.

3. ANC Manifestos in Xhosa.y

4. An extract from the ANC Constitution which deals with the objectives of our organisation. This to assists the volunteers to explain the policy of the ANC.

5. Lastly if possible copies of Freedom Charter will be part of the canvassers' education kit.

The volunteers will be provided with note books and pencils where they will record the names of people who will have been canvassed by them they will record the name of the chief with whom they will have negotiated for a meeting together with names of villagers who will be visited.

30 Districts will be covered in this campaign they are:

Butterworth- Idutywa, willovale, Ngamakwe, Centane.

Ngoobo- Cala, Tsomo, Cofimvaba, Elliot.

Umtata- Libode, quleni, Elliotdale, ananduli, Tsolo

Kokstad- Hzimkulu, Matatiele, Mt. Fletcher, Mt. Aylif.

Lusikisiki- Port St. Johns, Flagstaff, Bizana.

Mount Flere- Ugie, Maclear.

Qumbu- Tabankulu.

Media must be fully involved in the work of these task groups and dissemination and the exchange of information will play a vital role in making their work effective.

In so far as the co-ordinators are concerned they will have a hands on involvement so that the progress or lack of it can be gauged at all times.

The volunteer teams will, in addition, to contacts with chiefs also seek the co-operation of teachers and priests who may assist in providing accommodation at their school and churches.

Ivy Gcina who is accompanying us will have to be provided with two other activities from Women's League in Transkei who together will visit and work in rural areas where they will endeavour to gain support for the ANC election campaign. This should be simultaneous with the beginning of the campaign to deploy volunteers to the villages.

We propose to set up core six hundred volunteers contributed to in equal proportion by the 3 regions. Namely: Transkei, Port Elizabeth and East London. The following provisions have been budgeted for and we accordingly request the National Election Commission to provide:

Six hundred volunteers at R20 per day for duties to be carried out beyond normal working hours for the period of 34 days.

All the money to be provided will be properly accounted and all expenses incurred will be recorded and supporting invoices will be kept because the task that we have been given will end on the 24th of April we earnestly request your kind consideration of this representation. We will be grateful for your co-operation.
